  - Changes on our General Assembly Approved Position of Vice President of Diversity.
  - Funds' Allocation for Affinity Groups.
    - GSA exec board will petition the GA to commit to sending funds to the affinity groups directly in lieu of funding a new VP for DEI. We will request that \$2,000 each be sent to APIGSA, AIGSA, BGSA, and QTGSU. We will ask that this be made a permanent annual commitment, such that the affinity groups do not need to request this money from future GAs. We will vote on this at the June GA meeting.

  - Budget review and proposed for the next year.
- Discussion Items
  - o COVID-19 Relief Funds
    - GSA budget line items that may have unspent funds pending Fall reopening:
      - Travel to UCSA/UCGPC/UC Lobbying: \$4,000
      - Co-Presidents' Travel Fund: \$1,000
      - UCSA/UCGPC Travel: \$3,000
      - Travel UC Systemwide Conferences: \$3,000
      - Travel State Lobby Efforts: \$2,500
      - General Assembly meetings: \$5,000
      - Reduced social events (Bagel hour/Mosher Time/Lounge): \$10,000
      - Total: \$28,500
  - COVID-19 Relief Guidelines
    - COVID-19 Relief Fund requires the emergency to be COVID19-related.
    - Applicants for the COVID-19 relief fund do not need to have taken out available loans (different from Emergency grant).
    - A three-member panel will review all applications to ensure they meet the guidelines.
  - Allocation of Annual funding to Affinity Groups

- Following discussion with affinity group leaders, the decision has been made by the GSA exec board not to move forward with establishing the VP for Diversity, Equity and Inclusion.
- Affinity groups expressed concern that the position could be co-opted by admin to bypass meeting with affinity groups themselves.
- Instead, affinity groups proposed using the money that would have funded the new VP position to offer permanent annual support to affinity groups.
- We ask that GSA commit to allocating \$8,000 to fund affinity groups.
  \$2,000 each would be sent to APIGSA, AIGSA, BGSA and QTGSU.
- This would be an annual commitment from the GSA, to offer permanent financial support to affinity groups.

- Vote to approve budget for next year 2021-2022 // PASSED [19 yes, 0 no, 0 abstain]
