- <u>Health Insurance:</u>
 - Next year, health insurance premiums for grads will be fully decoupled from undergrads; this means that we are taking a <u>big</u> increase to our rates; in addition, there will be votes for making physical therapy free and extending trans health care and STI testing which can further impact our rates
- Housing:
 - Still working on revisiting the prioritization criteria of Family Housing so that married couples aren't prioritized over unmarried couples; the UC Legal office is not responding
 - San Clemente application will be open to continuing students from February 28th to March 10th (NOW); applying does not guarantee a spot, but you may be eligible even if not in SCV right now!!
