Robert's Rules of Order: A Brief Overview

Robert's Rules of Order Motion Steps

1. **Motion:** A member rises or raises a hand to signal the chairperson. *"I move to..."* for approving, adjourning
2. **Second:** Another member seconds the motion.
"Second!" or *"I second the motion"*
3. **Restate motion:** The chairperson restates the motion.
4. **Discussion:** The members may discuss the motion.
5. **Vote:** The chairperson restates the motion, and then first asks for affirmative votes, and then negative votes.
"All in favor? Opposed? Abstaining?"
6. **Announce the vote:** The chairperson announces the result of the vote and any instructions.

Emergency Grant

Currently **31 applicants have been approved** (47.69%) amounting to **\$29,135**. Applicants who were denied either had too much in savings, were not eligible for the grant as they have already applied twice, had loans available, or did not apply for FAFSA (which they were eligible for).

Childcare Grant

The GSA **lifted** the 5 quarters max award during a student's academic tenure.

Currently **45 applicants** have been approved! **\$15,900** has been awarded to student parents of **\$16,000**. **Carry forward is still available!**

Travel Grant

There are currently **141 applicants** for Fall quarter! **88** applicants (62.41%) have submitted their proof of attendance and receipts. Email reminders have been sent to all applicants.
